

English

In our English lessons, we'll be continuing with our Drawing Club sessions, focusing on key texts such as 'The Queen's Hat', 'I'm a Firefighter' and non-fiction books about The Great Fire of London.

Maths

In maths, we will be mastering place value within 10 and addition and subtraction within 10.

Science

Our topic in science this term is 'Everyday Materials' and specifically looking at identifying and naming everyday materials, describing their properties and comparing and grouping them.

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about our local area of St Neots and comparing our town to the city of London. We will also learn more about the 4 countries that make up the UK.

PSHE

Our topics in PSHE this term will focus on new beginnings and friends, family and anti-bullying.

Art and Design Technology

The children will be creating their own pieces of art based on the artist Paul Klee and his painting 'Castle and Sun'. In DT, we will be making our own Tudor house from the Great Fire of London using junk modelling.

Computing

In our computing lessons, we will be learning about technology around us and using technology to create a digital painting.

Music

We will be creating music around the theme of 'The Great Fire of London' and 'Fantasy and Adventure'.

We'll be keeping active this term doing gymnastics and we will also have a unit on dance and yoga. Our PE days are Monday and Tuesday.
